

ASTC Passport Program Policies

The Harvard Museum of Natural History is pleased to participate in ASTC's Passport Program and to welcome visitors from other participating institutions.

At the HMNH, the travel benefit is available to the cardholder from a participating institution plus one additional adult and two children, all residing at the same address.

The following rules and restrictions apply:

- Please be prepared to show your home institution membership card with the ASTC logo. We cannot offer free admission to visitors who do not have their cards with them. There are no exceptions to this policy.
- Members of participating institutions within a 90 mile radius are excluded from the program.
- In addition, to receive benefits you must live more than 90 miles from Cambridge. We reserve the right to request proof of residence.

The following institutions are within a 90 mile radius of Cambridge:

- SEE Science Center, Manchester

- Haffenreffer Museum of Anthropology, Brown University, Providence, RI
